




# Brundall School News - 7

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I hope you have had a chance to read the OFSTEd report on the school, which notes many of the strengths that continue to give us the 'Good' grading, as well as encouraging us to keep working on areas to improve, for example, making sure we prepare pupils for life in a diverse, multi-cultural country.

Lots of learning is in evidence around the school these past few days-the exciting in-role trip of the Owls to 1940s evacuation Britain is being continued this afternoon by paintings evoking the London skyline during the Blitz. The Bitterns are on the field playing a tag-rugby strategy game, adding to the cross country trials we have seen this week at lunchtime. Puffins were preparing shields and helmets for their learning about Romans, while the Golden Orioles were using the lap-tops and the internet, alongside some textbooks, to research the Romans. Hawks were recalling words using the 'oi' pattern. We have welcomed several prospective parents over the past few days it was a pleasure to show them around the school seeing the variety of learning taking place, as well as the contribution parents are making, from library to grounds to classroom help.


