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It's been wonderful having the children back in school and seeing how excited and eager they are, both to be learning and to be back with their friends. We are in week four of the full return and working hard to take on the changes and challenges at this time.

We know some schools have already been encountering reported cases of Covid and needing to close 'bubbles' in response. We are attaching our Remote Learning Plan, as if classes/bubbles or the school had to enter a quarantine or isolation phase, we would look to begin eLearning again, and staff are preparing for this possibility. This plan gives a brief outline; more information will be forthcoming as we develop plans and delivery methods.

This has been a period of enormous changes and a time to reflect on what the core purpose of our school is. We have our vision of Achievement and Creativity for All, and events that took place over the past months resonated with our mission in thinking about the community and children we serve. The Black Lives Matter protests were a reminder that education must include all of our community and nation, and that different voices and perspectives need to be heard as a vital part of going forward. This also applies to the questions of gender equality and pay gaps that were in the news during the lockdown. Both of these issues challenge us to think about the quality and content of our education at Brundall and to consider how we can be inclusive in our practice and help our children be thoughtful about these big questions and concerns.

Our aim is to help all our children become confident individuals, successful learners and responsible citizens, and these three aims will be essential for this changing and dynamic world that our children are growing up into.



Are you eligible for Free School Meals?

Families who receive certain benefits may be eligible for free school meals. Your child is eligible for free school meals if you're in receipt of one of the following benefits:

- Universal Credit with an annual net earned income of no more than £7,400.
- Income Support
- Income-based Jobseeker's Allowance
- Income-related Employment and Support Allowance
- Support under Part 6 of the Immigration and Asylum Act 1999
- The guarantee element of Pension Credit
- Working Tax Credit run-on (paid for the four weeks after you stop qualifying for Working Tax Credit)
- Child Tax Credit (with no Working Tax Credit) with an annual income of no more than £16,190

Registering for free meals could also raise an extra **£1,320** for your child's primary school, to fund valuable support like extra tuition, additional teaching staff or after school activities.

This additional money is available from central government for every child whose parent is receiving one of the benefits listed above.
