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Thank you to those parents and carers who shared their thoughts about last week's newsletter. It was good to get a range of feedback about how people perceived the matters of diversity, inclusion and equalities, as the school has a legal duty to promote this agenda under various guidance published by the Department for Education ranging from British Values to Equalities legislation.

Building work continues at pace, and we are getting used to accommodating the space required by the contractors. The disruption will continue! Equipment for the demolition of the bungalow will be coming on site from next week; and around half term, the contractors will need to fence off part of parking lot and the Reception/Administration entrance to the school. This will necessitate further changes, including a temporary intercom system for visitors. We are continuing with our current requests that parents remain off school premises, both to support social distancing with regard to COVID, and after half term as there will be limited access to our administration office. Last week we enjoyed our first Virtual Assembly and it was really lovely to see all of the children and feel a sense of all coming together to celebrate the achievements of others.

A summary for parents regarding how children have settled into school will be coming home on Friday 6th November. On this date, we will also be providing parents with a copy of individual targets if your child requires additional support. It has been a difficult time in terms of communication with us being unable to hold meetings, and we have used this term to identify targets after a substantial amount of time away from school, or to ensure that any targets from March are still relevant to the child's needs at this time. Our priority in returning to school was to ensure that children felt happy and confident, and that we focused on their wellbeing and being part of a class once again. Our target setting is about assessing the child for any barriers to learning that they may be facing. We then plan what to do to meet those particular needs and carry out the plan; the last part of the process being to review. This is called Assess, Plan, Do, Review (APDR) and this will be the format that you will receive if your child has additional needs.

Parent's Evening

As with everything this year, Parent's Evening arrangements will take a different form. We will be sending out a summary of how your child has settled into their new class and this will be handed out on Friday 6th November. There will also be a parent feedback form and we would really like to receive feedback on how you feel your child has settled back into school life.


