Dear Parents and Carers

We are glad to welcome your children back to school after half term, and glad to be remaining open during this next phase of Covid restrictions.

School really is the place for our children to be present to learn the academic and social skills they need to become successful learners, confident individuals and responsible citizens.

If further information is made available to schools about any changes to guidance provided by Public Health England or the Department of Education, we will let you know as soon as we can.

For now, we would ask that you continue to follow the procedures established. These include:

- Only one adult bringing the child to school
- Respecting social distancing outside the school
- Arriving on time so that we decrease congestion outside the school and can keep children in their class groups
- Ensuring that if a member of the household has symptoms, you arrange for testing and isolate until a clear result is returned

Given the increase in infection rates, we appreciate those parents and carers who are wearing masks at drop-off and collection. Although we are outside, and this minimizes risk of transmission, the mask adds another level of protection and also reminds us to stay safe and keep socially distanced.

The next phase of the pandemic will present challenges as we continue with the building work and the changes in weather. We will look to your continued co-operation with us as we provide the essential service of Education for the pupils of Brundall Primary School.
