**Appointments:**  
Following the success of our service last year, appointments will take the same format this summer. They are recommended for new starters (rather than online ordering) and will be bookable online. Pre-register now, if you don't already have an online account, and we'll send you an email in advance of booking opening.

**The recommended appointment window for your school is 9<sup>th</sup> August until 15<sup>th</sup> August.** Please, where possible, book during this window. This helps us to maximise school specific stock and reduce the time taken to serve you.

#### Online Ordering:

Our website will continue to operate as normal. **Orders should be placed by Sunday 1<sup>st</sup> August, to ensure in stock items can be delivered for the start of the autumn term.**

If you choose our 'Click&Collect' service when ordering you can collect, even when our branches are open 'by appointment only'. However, we may need to ask you to queue to pick up your order, while we manage social distancing in our stores.
