We will provide home learning through:

- Online learning portals Office 365 TEAMS
- Online material linked to those recommended by DfE
- Pre-recorded video
- Educational websites / videos

Teachers will:

- Set assignments
- Deliver planned, well sequenced lessons
- Assess progress by questions on the portal and check that work has been completed
- Tailor the learning based on the children's response to the learning

TEAMS PLATFORM

As a school we now access Office 365 and TEAMS as our online portal. All children will receive an email address and a password. This will be different to the previous google sign in, as we no longer use this as a school.

Accounts can be accessed by going to the Brundall School website and clicking on the email link on the home page.

Using your child's email and password you can log onto the account.

On the left hand side of the page will be a series of icons and you will need to select TEAMS



to access the home learning portal
